FP7 Key facts and figures

Applications:

As of 2013/10/25, a total of

- 1.244 eligible proposals were submitted in response to 467 FP7 calls for proposals involving 1.344 applicants from BRANDENBURG (1,92% of DE and 0,27% of EU-28*)
- requesting EUR 395,55m of EC contribution (1,38% of DE and 0,22% of EU-28*)

Among the NUTS1 regions of Germany (DE), BRANDENBURG ranks:
- 11th in terms of number of applicants and
- 11th in terms of requested EC contribution

Among the NUTS1 regions of EU-28*, BRANDENBURG ranks: - 74th in terms of number of applicants and

- 72nd in terms of requested EC contribution

Success rates:

- The BRANDENBURG applicant success rate of 21,0% is lower than the DE applicant success rate of 24,3% and
- similar to the EU-28* applicant success rate of 20,9%.

 The BRANDENBURG EC financial contribution success rate of 22,2% is lower than the DE rate of 23,7% and higher than the EU-28* rate of 19,7%.

Specifically, following evaluation and selection, a total of 257 proposals were retained for funding (20,7%)

- involving 282 (21,0%) successful applicants from BRANDENBURG and requesting EUR 87,98m (22,2%) of EC financial contribution

Among the NUTS1 regions of Germany (DE), BRANDENBURG ranks:

- 13th in terms of applicants success rate and 11th in terms of EC financial contribution success rate

Among the NUTS1 regions of EU-28*, BRANDENBURG ranks:

- 54th in terms of applicants success rate and 33rd in terms of EC financial contribution success rate

Signed grant agreements

- As of 2013/10/25, BRANDENBURG participates in 239 signed grant agreements involving 3.277 participants of which 254 (7,75%) are from BRANDENBURG
- benefiting from a total of EUR 952,13m of EC financial contribution of which EUR 77,92 m (8,18 %) is dedicated to participants from BRANDENBURG.

- 13th in budget share

Among the NUTS1 regions of EU-28*, BRANDENBURG (DE) ranks: - 77th in number of participations and

- 70th in budget share

- SME performance and participation
 The BRANDENBURG SME applicant success rate of 16,37% is lower than the DE SME applicant success rate of 22,92% and it is lower than the EU-28* SME applicant success rate of 20,17%.
 The BRANDENBURG SME EC financial contribution success rate of 14,37% is lower than the corresponding DE
- rate of 23,21% and it is lower than the corresponding EU-28* rate of 20,08%.

- 342 BRANDENBURG SME applicants requesting EUR 81,34m
- 56 (16,37%) successful SMEs requesting EUR 11,69m (14,37%)

- In signed grant agreements, as of 2013/10/25, 50 BRANDENBURG SME grant holders, i.e., 19,69% of total BRANDENBURG participation EUR 10,51m, i.e., 13,49% of total BRANDENBURG budget share


